Long and Bass Lake Association, Inc.

I/We _____ pledge to participate in Wisconsin's Healthy Lakes & Rivers initiative. More property owners implementing the suggested best practices over time may eventually add up to significant success and healthier waters for Long Lake and Bass Lake—for current and future generations.

I/We pledge to work with DNR Surface Water Grant sponsor **Long and Bass Lake Association Inc.** to install the following best practice(s) to restore fish and wildlife lakeshore habitat and/or prevent stormwater runoff and erosion.

Check practices to be installed on the property:

- Fish Sticks — bundles of trees/branches anchored in shallow water for fish habitat
- Native Plantings — 350+ sq ft garden of native plants that filters runoff
- Rain Garden — shallow planted depression that captures and infiltrates runoff
- Diversion Practice(s) — redirect stormwater runoff away from the lake
- Rock Infiltration Practice(s) — gravel trenches that capture and filter runoff

Grant Benefit: The Healthy Lakes & Rivers program provides up to \$1,000 per practice (75% state cost-share). The Association applies for grant funding on behalf of participating property owners—your out-of-pocket cost is approximately \$250 per practice.

I/We understand that by signing this Pledge I/we am/are indicating a strong interest to follow through with a Healthy Lakes & Rivers project on my/our property, but this is not a legal requirement.

What happens next? After you sign this pledge, a representative from the Association and/or Lincoln County will contact you to schedule a brief site visit to assess your property and discuss which practices are the best fit. There is no cost or obligation for the site visit.
